Approaching from the cast, at the intersection of Burnet County Roads 207 and 206, travel west on 206 for 1.3 miles to the dirt road to the cemetery. Oldest grave: 1873. Cemetery was still in use in 1988.

Description: Located about 3 miles SW of Austonio off farm road 1280. The land for the cemetery was given to the community for a cemetery, school and church sometime before 1835 by a Mr. Bobby Boggs. He was married to Susan Cheairs and many of the Cheairs still live in the community. Later the school and church was moved to another location about 2 miles from the cemetery and the new community became known as the Ash community.
