Linnie Schilling Alford

Am trying to determine what ALFORD Linnie (Schilling) (Simmons) married (Re: page 608, Cemetery Inscriptions, Pike County, MS, 1750-1978, by Ray and June Sartin Parish).

The book; Genealogical Outline of the Descendants of John Smith and John Brown Families, by Reta Smith Bond, says her first name is Linnie Schilling and the 1880, 1900, 1910 and 1920 Pike County, MS Censuses say she is Linnie Schilling.

There is nothing definite that says the below Lennie D. Schilling is the right Linnie (Lennie, Lonnie or Linnie) Schilling, but, she has the same birth month/year and she was married to a Howard Simmons.

Linnie D. SCHILLING was born on September 19, 1879 in Mississippi. Note: She was listed as 2/12(9/12?) year old on the 1880 census, 20 (Sep 1879) on the 1900 census, 29 on the 1910 census, 48 on the 1920 census. She appeared on the census in 1880 in Pike County, MS. Note: Listed with parents, District 1, Beat 1, page 356A, dwelling 404, family 407. She appeared on the census in 1900 in Pike County, MS. Note: Listed with parents, Beat 1, page 22B, dwelling 391, family 391. She appeared on the census in 1910 in Pike County, MS. Note: Beat 1, page 21A, dwelling 178, family 179. She appeared on the census in 1920 in Mississippi. Note: Beat 1, page 7A, dwelling 111, family 111. She died on October 3, 1947. She was buried in Silver Springs Baptist Church Cemetery, Pike County, MS. D/O Rev. Esco Martin Schilling and Eveline Elizabeth Ellzey.

Linnie D. SCHILLING was married to Howard SIMMONS before 1903. Note: Based on birth of Ora Simmons about 1903. Howard SIMMONS was born about 1877 in Mississippi. Note: He was listed as 33 on the 1910 census, 42 on the 1920 census. He appeared on the census in 1910 in Pike County, MS. Note: Beat 1, page 21A, dwelling 178, family 179. He appeared on the census in 1920 in Pike County, MS. Note: Beat 1, page 7A, dwelling 111, family 111. S/O ? and ?.

I have not done a lot with this branch of my family, but here is what I have. I am especially interested in any info on Hophni or Hopkins Alford born abt. 1806 in Massachusetts, and Henry H. Alford born 9 Oct 1871 at 8 Bear St., Lyons, NY.

This is what I have:

Hopni or Hopkins Alford and Eliza Ann Pease (born abt. 1809 in Lyons, NY and died abt 1890 in Lyons, NY). Both are buried in Lyons Rural Cemetery. They had one known son:

William Henry Harrison Alford b 2 Sep 1840 in Lyons, NY. He married Josephine Elizabeth McCumber on 30 Sept 1868 in Lyons, NY. Josephine McCumber was born 23 Mar 1847 in Phoenix, NY and died 14 Apr. 1914 in Lyons, NY. William Henry Harrison Alford died 12 Feb. 1934 in Lyons, NY.

Their Children, all of whom were born on 8 Bear St., Lyons, NY are:

Henry H. Alford b. 9 Oct. 1871 d. March 1913, "out west"
Eunice E. Alford b. 28 March 1875 d. 3 May 1934, in Lyons, NY

Myrtie Alford b. 26 Feb 1879 d. 1880
Chester Alford b. 5 May 1881 c. 1882
Walter Alford b. 17 Oct 1885
