four of us, Doris, Buzz, Mary and I took off on a trip to the north via the California costal highway. Mary and I were in the minivan loaded down with books full of dead Alford data following Doris and Buzz who were in a speedy little white rental car. We spent several days together along the coast making it into Oregon before the Vetri's had to return to San Francisco to catch their flight back to New Jersey. It was an experience that none of us will ever forget and now as I look back on my times with Buzz I am so glad we got to make that trip together.
