"ALFORDS" IN THE 1850 CENSUS OF GEORGIA

Arranged by county, page, dwelling and family.

This is an enhanced version of this census unit. The original basic census data as it was published in AAFA ACTION Fall 1996 is unchanged.

To enhance this version AAFA has added a reference for the household head following the entry about the census date. On the main line of data for each subject the circa year of birth (CYOB) was computed by subtracting the age from the census year. AAFA notes have been added to sometimes explain what we think we know about the family.

For most subjects the age is expressed in years immediately after the sex entry. In some cases - particularly with infants - the age is expressed in months in which case the age column is blank. The age- when expressed in months is in the seldom used column immediately after age.

Color is shown after the age. It is assumed to be white unless otherwise specified.

Birthplace is shown with the approved postal abbreviations for states in the U.S.

Foreign places were abbreviated as IR = Ireland and SX = Saxony,

In 1850 the Federal Census began to collect much more information than in any previous census. Some of that information is coded as follows: S = in school this year. M = married in the census year. R = can't read and/or write (in some cases the enumerator indicated they could not write and that is shown with a W.

Column headings are not meant to line up exactly over the data but rather to give position relationship

Census data comes from microfilm series M432.
