

"ALFORDS" IN THE 1870 TEXAS CENSUS - ENHANCED

This census unit, without any enhancement, was published in AAFA ACTION #17, June 1992, pages 45-53.

Arranged by county, page and dwelling.

The basic census is a product of the AAFA census team. It has been verified and double checked to ensure that it reflects the true and accurate content of the original census schedules. Only those elements considered to be of genealogical or historical value are included here.

The "enhancement" in the form of AAFA NOTES does not come from the census but is the combined effort of several AAFA members closely associated with the Alford data. Enhancement is a work in progress and is not complete. The object is to include notes with each household that will answer the logical or typical questions one might ask upon viewing the record. Questions such as: Who are these folks? Where did they come from? What do the initials mean? What was the wife's maiden name? What is the relationship to the other surname/s listed? Where was the family in the previous census? Where was the family in the next census? What is their reference in the main AAFA data base? These references are usually eight characters that suggest the persons name, year of birth and state of birth. Like WIL839AL What is their identification number in the genealogy files? These are called BK (short for Brothers Keeper) numbers. Other human interest information that might make the census data more meaningful and useful.

For most subjects the age is expressed in years immediately after the sex entry. In some cases - particularly with infants - the age is expressed in months in which case the age column is blank. When the age is expressed in months it is in the next seldom used column immediately after age. In 1870 the census taker was also supposed to record the month of birth and that is shown in the next column if the data was available.

Birthplace is shown with the approved postal abbreviations for states in the U.S. Foreign places, when applicable, were abbreviated as follows: EN = England, IR = Ireland, SW = Sweden and GM = Germany

Color is shown after the birthplace (BP). It is assumed to be white unless otherwise specified. W is white, B is black and M is mulatto.

More data was collected in 1870 than in any prior year. The information is coded as follows:

S = in school this year. R = can't read and W = can't write. V = eligible to vote.

If either of the parents of the subject was foreign born then an F denotes the father was and an M that the mother was.

"Block protect" was used here to ensure family groups were not split or separated from their header. As a consequence there may be more white space than expected
