It has been enhanced with comments regarding the 1870 census plus AAFA information about the families or subjects. AAFA is most appreciative of the work done by the LDS Church on this census. A future update will also address the 1900 census interface more completely.

The pagination may appear strange to some, but the data has been structured so that page breaks do not fall in the middle of a family. That sometimes creates some white space at the bottom of the page. Use it for your notes.

This is not a product of the AAFA census team which for over 20 years has been extracting data from the original census images, verifying, and publishing it in the AAFA quarterly. Some unites are on the website.
