 Arthur Alford to Southrin Alford

Know all men by these presents that I Arthur Alford of Horry District the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of \$40 lawful money to me in hand paid by Southrin Alford of the District and State aforesaid have granted, bargained, sold and released, by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Southrin Alford ~~of the~~ all that piece, parcel, or tract of land containing ~~394~~ 394 acres be the same more or less, being part of a tract granted Wm. Snow the 10<sup>th</sup> day of March 1792 and sold at Sheriff's sale the 2<sup>nd</sup> of December 1816 to me Arthur Alford and hath such shape and marks, buttings and boundings as are represented in the plat annexed to said grant beginning at David Anderson's corner, running South 15 to a pine corner, from thence S. 35. E. 92" 50 to a stake pine from thence S. 55 E. 42" 50 to a stake corner from thence N 26 W 25 to stake corner, thence N 20 W. 10 to a pine corner from thence to David Anderson upper corner and so round said Anderson to a pine corner first above mentioned.

Together with all and singular the rights members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said

premises belonging or in any wise  
incident or appurtenant.

To Have and to Hold all and  
singular the premises before mention  
unto the said Sutherland Alford, his  
heirs and assigns forever, and  
I do hereby bind myself my heirs  
executors, administrators and  
assigns forever, as to warrant &  
forever defend all and singular the  
said premises unto the said Sutherland  
Alford his heirs and assigns &  
against myself, my heirs, and  
every other person, lawfully claiming  
the same or any part thereof.

1817 and in the 42<sup>nd</sup> year of Sovereignty  
and Independence of the United States  
of America.
