Long also of the County of Worry in
the State aforesaid, (the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged) have granted,
bargained, sold and released, and by these
presents do grant, bargain, sell and
release unto the said Mary F. Long
and to her heirs and assigns forever,
All and singular that certain piece,
parcel, and tract of land containing
one hundred and eighty-three (183)
Acres more or less, situate, lying and
being in the County of Worry and State
aforesaid, on Mill Branch in the Township
of Bucks, the land hereby conveyed is a
part of a tract of Three Hundred and
eight (308) Acres deeded to me by my
father John M. Woodward by his

deed bearing date the Twenty-Sixth (26)
day of February A.D. 1874, and has
such shapes, makes, and boundaries
as is shown by a plat of the same
made by C. B. Jarvis D.S. the 23rd day
of March A.D. 1874, Bounded as
follows; On the South by Mill Branch,
and part of the said 308 acres tract,
by West & South West by lands of Robert
Lowmire and Jack Todd: North by
lands of Alexander Bourn: East,

will more fully explain.


