To the worshipful Court of pleas and quarter  
sefsions [sic] for the county afore said. The Undersigned  
appointed at the last Term of this court commifsioning [sic]  
To make sale of the following Negro slaves in  
the case of the Petition of Wilie Butler & wife,  
John Mitchel, Wilie Clifton & others  
respectfully reports That in pursuance of  
said order he did on the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of June  
last after advertising according to said order  
sell said negro slaves in the Town of  
Rolesville on a credit of six months when  
Wilie Clifton became the purchaser of Annes  
& her child Letheaw, at Five hundred Dolers [sic] &  
give his bond for that sum with John  
Mitchell & Thos. T. Clifton his securities  
Thos. T. Clifton became the purchaser of  
Step. at Four hundred & eighty five Dolears [sic]  
& fifty cents and give his bond for that sum  
with Wilie Clifton & John Mitchell  
his securities all of which is Respectfully  
submitted [sic] the 13<sup>th</sup> of August, 1846.
