Ex Parte This cause coming on to be heard
 on the Petition & proofs it is ordered
 and decreed that the prayer of the
Petitioners be granted and that the negro slaves to wit
Stepney, Annice and Lethream in the pleadings named
be sold on a credit of six months_ and the Court
doth appoint Joseph Fowler as a commifsioner [sic] to make
said sale and he is to give thirty days
notice by public advertisement of the time, hours, &
place of sale & said sale to be made in the town of
Rolesville, and he is to take bond with good
Securities of the purchasers, and report his
proceedings in the premise to the next Court.

Genl. G. M Haywood, please to write the names of the Negro
named in the above Decree plain So I can understand
these names & things ought to be written plain.
