Jacob Alford b. 1781 NC**

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1. **Jacob Alford** #5179 b. about 1781, Franklin Co., NC, (son of John Alford #5167 and Chloe Pope #5177) m. **Milberry "Milbre" Gray** #5183, b. about 1779, North Carolina, d. after 1860, Meridian, Lauderdale Co., MS. Jacob died 1838, Lauderdale Co., MS.

"John Alford, eldest son of Julius and Lucy Alfor, is shown as a tithable in his father's family in Bute Co., N.C. in 1771, indicating his birth as prior to 1755 (probably about 1750), and seems to have died in Greene Co., Ala. after 1830 (he is apparently the aged man, aged 70-80, shown in the family of his son, Abraham Alford, in Greene Co., Ala. in the Census of 1830). John Alford and Chloe his wife deeded land in Bute Co., N.C. April 12, 1775 (Bute Co., D.B. 5, p. 285), . . . John Alford had at least one son, Abraham Alford, to whom he deeded land in Franklin Co. in 1820 (D.B. 20, p. 75), and to whose children, Fenner, Kelly, Rebecca, Henderson, Hilliard and John H. Alford, John Alford, Sr. acknowledged deeds of gift at the Franklin Co. Court in March, 1821. The last appearance of John and Abraham Alford in Franklin Co., N.C. was in 1826 when Abraham Alford gave a power of attorney to Hardy W. Tharpe to secure a slave who had escaped from John Alford, Sr. (Franklin Co., D.B. 25, p. 119). John and Abraham Alford must have moved almost at once to Greene Co., Ala., where Abraham was deeded land in 1827, and John was apparently living in Abraham's family, aged 70-80, in 1830. Other sons of John Alford were apparently John Alford, Jr., Jacob Alford and Thomas Alford . . .", Mrs. John Bennett Boddie, HISTORICAL SOUTHERN FAMILIES, VOL XII" pp. 60-62

Peggy Schuster who has done considerable research on this branch of the family reports "they" think Gray Sanderford was son of Milberry 's sister. "They" say they migrated with the wagon train of Carpenters, Tutts, Rices, Denton, Richardsons, Sanderfords, etal from NC to Alabama in the 1820's and to Mississippi in the 1830's. Jacob later moved to Pine Springs Community of Lauderdale Co., MS.

Jacob's estate, (final settlement March 1844 - copies to Lynn Shelley for AAFA library) administered by Littleberry Bains (son-in-law) and showing Milbra as the widow, listed the heirs and legatees in the following order (some annotations by Peggy Schuster): Richard B. Jacob bought 40 acres, SE 1/4 of Se 1/4 section 9, Oct 1836, pat. 1841 Melva Alford sold land to James G. Alford Dec 23 1846, E 1/2 NE 1/4 Sec 9

An unidentified "genealogy" sent by Peggy Schuster shows a son Owen Alford who was in the 1840 Lauderdale Co. Census. No good reason to make him a part of this family at this time.

Appeal from Chancery Court of Mobile

Bill filed by WILLIAM L. MCDOW, the appellee to enjoin a certain action at law instituted against him by the appellant, WILLIAM BYRNE, as administrator of JOSIAH THOMAS, deceased.

One JACOB ALFORD, as principal, and one ACHILLES EDWARDS, surety, made their Joint note to one JOSIAH THOMAS for sum of \$2875 payable on 1 Jan. 1836. Said makers of note were then residents of Greene Co. and said THOMAS a resident of the State of Va. Said THOMAS brought suit on note on 12 July 1838 in U.S. Court for Southern District of Ala. against said ALFORD and EDWARDS.

While suit was pending against said EDWARDS and before judgement was rendered, he departed this life, leaving a will naming therein on TASKER his executor.

[No further mention of ALFORD etc.]
