Hi,

This email, sent primarily to those who have something to do with our deceased members, and the attachment will serve to close the case, on my end, on AAFA #0565, Nealy Preston Alford, AS SOON AS I GET AN AHNENTAFEL FROM JANICE - or her ok to make it here from her file. I guess it will get final closure when Ramona reads his name in Dallas next October 14 years after he died.

As you know Max and I have a continuing effort underway to try to upgrade the membership files as regards their address, email, ancestry, etc. Max you can add his family now

In 1993 Nealy P. Alford joined the association via the letter on page one of the attachment. In an effort to learn more about them and to help they as requested (alluded to) in their letter I sent them the letter on page 2 of the attachment As usual nothing happened and we let it drag until last year when I stumbled over them again - either to get an ahnentafel or to figure out for Max what the family code should be.

I checked the SSDI and found something that suggested our member had died in 1995. Seeing no other alternative I ordered a copy of his SS application (without cost to the AAFA) See page 3 of the attachment. By this time I had hit on several of you for help. The very next day received Lynn's email that is on page 4 of the attachment. Had I waited one more day I would not have needed the SS application.

With Lynn's information I checked Janice's Isham file and there was Nealy Preston Alford BK 2071 with his wife, Betty Ann Farrish (who must have written the letter on page 1) and three kids. Lynn's email provided the kids birthdates that are missing from the genealogy- as well as Nealy's data.

Page 5 and 6 is what I received today from the Social Security Administration (I thought my stimulus package had arrived).

I'm obviously not doing a very good job of looking for information on members within our small leadership group.

Dear Alfords,

I just began to prepare the Alford lineages to send to Pam Thompson for publication in the next quarterly and I noticed something very disturbing. I don't see evidence here of an awful lot of processing on your membership. If you did not receive a copy of the March quarterly within the last month or six weeks please drop me a note.

I should have sent you a letter or a note with an application blank on which you could record your Alford ancestry. You may remember that you applied for membership in your February 17 letter and it did not contain any genealogical information- other than a mention of Alabama connections.

Would you please complete the front side of the blue application form and the green Alford ancestry form and return them as soon as possible. I know that sounds dumb- asking you to hurry when I've apparently let your letter sit here and collect dust for three and a half months.

Assuming you did receive the last quarterly- the material I am working on is that similar to pages 4 - 11 except that our master data here in the computer contains much more information - such as vital statistics on the spouse and remarks as appropriate.

If you have any questions please let me know. I hope you will forgive me for this slip-up. I'm obviously trying to more than I'm capable of handling.



I found Neal P.'s TX Death Cert. (actually not the certificate but the death record) and he is Nealy Preston Alford, born 11 Jun 1925 and died 26 Sep 1995 as already determined by his SS#.


The closest I could come to parents are Hardeman T. (Hardman Talmadge in the AL marriage records married for the second time in Cherokee Co. AL in 1932) Alford and wife Nellie who have a son named NEELY in the 1930 census of Etowah Co. AL. Can't find Hardeman in WWI Draft Registration but he was born 1898 AL with parents born AL according to 1930 census.

Nealy Preston and wife Betty Ann Farris are in the TX Birth Index with the following children: (I think all born in Potter Co.??)

Richard Neal Alford born 7 Mar 1953 Nellanne born 31 Aug 1955 Gary Preston born 1 Feb 1957

There is a Nealy Alford born 20 Sep 1899 who died Nov 1985 (449-58-4257) in Hill Co. TX that I was trying to connect to Nealy Preston, but this older Nealy may have been a woman and I have not found more than the SSDI record.

John Rogers sent this at my request as I was searching for a connection for AAFA #0565, the late Neal P. Alford, 417-20-3583 who was b. in AL and died in Amarillo, TX, They submitted no information when they joined other than to say Neal's Alfords were in Alabama. I wrote them for more information a few months later and had no response. In working with Max on the membership file I decided to check the SSDI where I found he died just a couple years after joining AAFA just a couple years after joining AAFA.

I found a record in the 1930 Alabama census that looked close but after seeing this data from John Rogers I think it probably is not correct.

I am going to order, at my expense, a copy of Neal's ss application to see if won't give us a lead as to who his Alfords were. It will take forever to get the results but I'll try to remember to post you on it when I get something.

This message is provided primarily for Earline and the memorial album and for Pam and the In Remembrance article. Ramoa gets it as background for the memorial service at the meeting next year. Lynn is included in case she can help run him down.

This is all I have on Reuben Lafayette Alford. His father was Richard Mason Alford and granfather was Richard Redden Alford. There are quite a few holes, and I have no Neal Alford, but if he was born after 1940, I may not have a record of him. Also, Donald Alford could have been Donald Neal, possibly. I had to really dig and patch things together for this family.

(149) Richard Mason "Steely" "Drew"Alford, son of Richard Redden Alford, was born in December 1869 in Coffee County , Alabama . For some reason, after the death of his mother, Rebecca Phillips Alford, he went to live with her brother, his Uncle Hezekiah Phillips. Presumably, this was because of the fact there was a woman in the house to take care of the infant. In 1880 he was still listed with his uncle's family in Geneva County . His father remarried later, but not in time to take care of an infant. As a young man, he was married to an unknown spouse (?-1890) in about 1889. According to a family legend, told by John Richard Alford II, sons Reuben and James Irvin had different mothers, meaning "Steely's" first wife must have died after the birth of John Richard, his first child. "Steely" married Elifair Ellenor Malloy (4/12/1876-3/21/1920) in 1890. In 1900 he was listed as "Drusilla" Alford in Geneva County . They soon moved to Green Bay , Alabama (south of Opp on Hwy 331) in Covington County in 1901, where he died a year later in 1902. His wife soon remarried to Joseph Wise in Covington County (Green Bay). "Steely" had the following children: the following children:
