Know all men by these presents that I Joshua Long of the State aforesaid, have remised, released and forever quitclaim, and by these presents do for myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, remise, release and forever quitclaim unto John Alford his heirs, executors, administrators all and all manner of estate, right, title or interest unto a certain tract of land containing two hundred acres situate in the District aforesaid on the West side of Waccamaw River; it being part of a tract of sixteen thousand three hundred and sixty two acres which was granted unto Mosses Floyd in the year 1792 March 5th, by the Hbl. Charles Pinkney Esq., bounding the East side William Alford's land, on the South side Mr. Plimes' land, on the West side by James Jordan's land, on the North side by part of the same survey, and hath such shapes forms and marks as a plat of the same doth represent.
