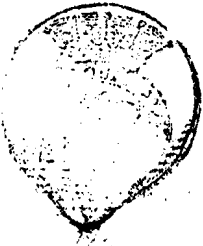

OBSERVING my Instructions to you for running out Lands: THREE just and fair Plans whereof, certified under your Hand, with the Day of your making the same, you are to return to the Person mentioned in my said Instructions for receiving the same, within Six Months from the Date of this Warrant; IN ORDER that the said

*James Alfred* may, within Twelve Months ensuing the Day of such your Survey, so to be returned as aforefaid, take out a Grant of the Lands therein contained, for completing his Title: OTHERWISE this Warrant to be void and of no Force; AND the said Lands to be deemed free, and at Liberty to be taken up by any other Person that shall apply to me for that Purpose. DATED the

*twentieth* Day of *Nov 1764*
