Sealed with our seals and dated this *31st* day of *December* 1821

THE condition of this obligation is such, that if there should be no legal cause to obstruct a marriage shortly intended to be solemnized between the said *Peter Connor about 21 years of age & Miss Elizabeth Alfred daughter of William Alfred whose consent was duly certified & approved* then this obligation to be void, else to remain in full force.
