Simmons, Ph.D., Woodrow—A resident of Hammond, he died Thursday, Aug. 15, 1996, at Hammond Nursing Home, Hammond.

He was 77 and a native of Washington Parish. He taught high school in Kentwood in the early 1940s, was assistant county agent of Tangipahoa Parish in the early 1950s, taught agriculture at SLU for 25 years and was in charge of SLU's dairy when it was located at Hammond Airport. He was a U.S. Army veteran of World War II.
