Momma. I called her momma as that was more prevalent in our lives than Pat. Patsy Sue (Robb) Waters was 73 years of age, born February 22, 1934 in Howard County, Missouri. We were married 54 of those years, raising a family of four children. Kansas City has been our home since leaving the service in 1958. Momma was reunited with the LORD at 9:00 P.M. on March 2, 2007 following thirteen years of congestive heart failure. She died peacefully with her family at St. Luke's Hospital North. Her wish was fulfilled to die in the same old iron bed in which she was born. Yes, we did take the bed to the hospital.

She was preceded in death by her parents William Roger and Georgie Eunice (Dennis) Robb and a brother, Dennis Paul Robb.
