Kae Shaw, 59, departed this life on March 17, 2008 at St. Elizabeth Hospital in Beaumont surrounded by her family and friends. She attended school in Coolidge, TX, through the eighth grade after which she graduated from Kirbyville High School in 1966. She married Perry Shaw on July 30, 1966, and graduated from Lamar University in 1975 with a degree in speech after which she began her career in 1975 as a speech therapist for Kirbyville Consolidated Independent School District. Kae enjoyed continued employment for 33 years until the day of her death.

To Kae and Perry's union were added two children, Leah Shaw Wheeler and Shelby Ray Shaw.
