The many kind remarks about the first issue of the ALFORD FAMILY BULLETIN are greatly appreciated. They have encouraged us to attempt issue no. 2.

The format has been changed so that a person searching in a particular State would not have to search thru material in other States which they cannot use. It is hoped this will be more useful.

We are including the 1880 Soundex (use of which was explained in Issue No. 1) for the State of Alabama Census in this issue. By ordering the particular references as shown on the Soundex, that particular sheet can be ordered from the Cashier, National Archives and Record Service, Washington, D. C. 20408. This will be a photostat showing the family and house number and the relationship of each member to the head of the household also the state from which the parents (of the head and his wife) were born. The fee is nominal.

It is regretted that we were unable to obtain this information to be included in this issue, before going to press.

Recently, we have obtained 3 new rolls of microfilm, two of which are on the Florida Wars for the States of Alabama and Louisiana, and one on Military Land Warrants under the Act of 1788 for the Military District of Ohio, 1799-1805. None of which we have finished checking for the Alford Family name.

Our next issue will contain the 1880 Soundex of the Georgia Census.

We sincerely appreciate the kind remarks re our ALFORD FAMILY BULLETIN by outstanding genealogical periodicals.

When bible or private records are sent us, please indicate if we may use them in the Bulletin to help others.

As usual your comments and contributions (with established proof) are earnestly requested.
