1. **Glenn Ashton Alford, Sr.** b. Jul 13 1919, Wilmer, Tangipahoa Parish, LA, m. Mar 9 1941, in Tallulah, Madison Parish, LA, **Elizabeth Givens**, b. Nov 13 1916, Ruston, Lincoln Parish, LA. Glenn died Sep 14 2002. Glenn joined the Louisiana State Police in 1940 and retired after almost 31 years of service with the force. From 1942-1945 he served in the U. S. Coast Guard for 3 1/2 years. Glenn is a founding member ALFORD AMERICAN FAMILY ASSOCIATION.

2. **Felder Fletcher Alford** b. Apr 2 1876, Near Wilmer, Tangipahoa Parish, LA, m. Jul 31 1911, **3. Della Herring**, b. May 1 1889, d. Jul 11 1971. Felder died Oct 25 1958, New Orleans, Orleans Parish, LA. He died in Ochner's Hospital.

4. **Ira Payne Alford** b. Jan 24 1822, Pike Co., MS, m. (1) Dec 30 1843, in Amite Co., MS, Elizabeth "Betsey" Hope, b. Jan 15 1826, d. Dec 25 1871, Washington Parish, LA, m. (2) Sep 19 1872, **5. Mary Hughes**, b. Mar 17 1837, d. Jan 7 1911, m. (1) John Watts Parker, b. Feb 1 1832, d. Jul 10 1863. Ira died Sep 15 1901, Washington Parish, LA. In 1850 he was enumerated in Washington Parish as Ira Olford 28 MS with wife Elizabeth 24 MS. Children were: Jane 5, James 4, Newton 3 and Martha 1 - all born in LA. Household also had Russell Bready 27 LA laborer. Ira was a farmer with \$700 property.

The 1860 census shows John N. 7 and Jephtha 5. Martha at age 1 was the youngest listed in 1850. Appears to be error in birth dates shown.

"... settled on a farm two miles west of the parentaly home and reared a large family." Tynes Diary

Ira purchased 297 acres in section 12, township 1S, range 8E from the Greensburg federal land office May 1, 1861

8. **Edwin Barksdale Alford** b. Nov 25 1792, Cumberland Co., NC, m. Dec 20 1818, in Pike Co., MS, **9. Martha Smith**, b. Mar 25 1802, South Carolina, d. Aug 8 1861, Pike Co., MS. Edwin died Mar 10 1878, Pike Co., MS. Edwin served as a Pvt. in Capt. Thos. Bickham's Co. 13th Regiment, Louisiana Militia; War 1812. Copy of military records on file with AAFA.

Sources for this record came from bits and pieces from descendants but primarily from a family group record compiled by the late Tressie Bowman which cited the 1850 census, Conerly's History of Pike County, MS 1798-1876 and data from grandson George Watson of Hattiesburg, MS.

E. Russ Williams updated Conerly and published a revised History of Pike County, MS and this record

was updated accordingly.

Edwin and his family was enumerated in Pike County, MS in 1850 and 1860. In 1850 he showed birth in Georgia but in 1860 in North Carolina. His father was enumerated in Cumberland Co., NC in 1790.

June 1, 1858 he purchased 38 acres from the federal land office in section 1, township 1S, range 8E.

He and Martha are supposed to be buried on what is, or was, the Eugene Smith farm but to the casual observer they appear to be buried on the highway right-of-way. Applicable dates taken from the gravestones. The book published on Pike Co. Cemeteries calls it the Edwin B. Alford Cemetery which is what will be used in this record.

The published cemetery record says he was born Nov 25 1792 and died May 10 1878 and Martha was born Mar 2 1802 and died Aug 8 1867. AAFA has the dates as shown in this record which are based on actual viewing of the stones by AAFA members.

16. **Jacob Alford** b. Aug 15 1761, Franklin Co., NC, occupation farmer, m. (1) about 1784, in North Carolina, Elizabeth Bryant, b. Jun 20 1765, d. 1789-92, Cumberland Co., NC, m. (2) about 1792, in Cumberland Co., NC, **17. Frankie Seaborn**, b. about 1763, Virginia, d. about 1859, Washington Parish, LA. Some folks believe her name was Martha, some Frances, and some include an initial B. In 1830 she was enumerated in Washington Parish as Franky B. Allford with three sons, a daughter and one slave. 00102-00100001-01 In 1840 she was enumerated with son Joseph, household also had male under 5. She and her son Joseph were enumerated in Washington Parish in 1850. Jacob died Jul 16 1824, Washington Parish, LA.

32. **Julius Alford** b. Sep 1717, St. Peter's Parish, New Kent Co., VA, occupation farmer, m. **33. Lucy _____**, d. after 1790, Franklin Co., NC. Julius died 1771, Bute Co., NC.

4th Great Grand Parents

64. **James Alford** b. about 1687, Probably New Kent Co., VA, died about 1730, New Kent Co., VA. Birth and death dates are estimates based on other recorded events in New Kent County, VA in the St. Peter's Parish Register. PLEASE NOTE: It is not proven that he was the son of John Alford but there is some circumstantial evidence indicating that he is.

128. **John Alford** b. about 1645, Probably Virginia, died Mar 14 1710, New Kent Co., VA.
