1. **Paul Richardson Reeves** b. Jul 26 1922, m. **Nellie Adams**. Paul died Mar 10 2000. He was a fighter pilot in World War II and flew 63 missions. He was recalled for duty in the Korean War. He was a bank examiner and president of Capital Building and Loan. He remained in the Air Force reserves and retired as a Lt. Col. He was once named LSU alumni of the year and served on the College Board and the Board of the Baton Rouge General Hospital. Paul was founding member ALFORD AMERICAN FAMILY ASSOCIATION, INC.

2. **Harry Richardson Reeves** b. Apr 16 1896, m. Jun 10 1921, in Tangipahoa Parish, LA, **3. Haidee Kathleen Alford**, b. Oct 26 1901, Terrebonne Parish, LA. Harry died May 8 1965, Hammond, Tangipahoa Parish, LA. He served in the Hospital Corps for eleven months in World War I. He was France from September 1918 through May 1919. He was principle of the high school for more than thirty years. Haidee was charter member #0210 ALFORD AMERICAN FAMILY ASSOCIATION.

6. **Bailey Monroe Alford** b. Jul 2 1875, Tangipahoa Parish, LA, m. Dec 31 1899, in Tangipahoa Parish, LA, **7. Alice Jane Brumfield**, b. Aug 12 1874, Tangipahoa Parish, LA, d. Apr 14 1959. Bailey died May 5 1932, New Orleans, Orleans Parish, LA.

12. **Marshall Thomas Alford** b. Sep 29 1839, Washington Parish, LA, m. Nov 20 1867, **13. Charity Ann Self**, b. Sep 19 1844, d. Nov 20 1922, Oakdale, Allen Parish, LA. Marshall died May 24 1904, Tangipahoa Parish, LA.

He was a private and corporal in companies A and K 3rd (Wingfield's) Louisiana Cavalry. He entered service at Camp Moore, Louisiana May 13th 1862. He was elected Corporal January 6 1863.

He homesteaded, from the Greensburg Federal land office, 81 acres Mar. 15, 1875 located in section 7, township 1S, range 10E.

The cemetery where they are buried is actually the Beulah Baptist Church Cemetery.

24. **John Seaborn Alford** b. Oct 11 1807, Washington Parish, LA, occupation Farmer, m. 1834, **25. Margaret Brumfield**, b. Feb 9 1819, Pike Co., MS, d. Sep 8 1885, Washington Parish, LA. John died Nov 15 1891, Washington Parish, LA. John Seaborn Alford is buried on property that was his farm. It was later known as the Iddo Alford Farm and in the 1990's was owned by Nolan David Alford- AAFA Member #0425. Data taken from their gravestones there. He was enumerated in 1840 Washington Parish with two sons and a daughter. 200001-10001

In 1850 Washington Parish he was enumerated as John Olford 40 LA with wife M. 35 LA. Children were: Madison 13, Marshall 12 and Jane 11 who were probably those in 1840. Other children were Emily 10, Sarah 9, Seaborn 8, S. (f) 7, Willis 5, Isaac 4 and John 1. He was a farmer with \$1500 property.

In the 1850 agricultural census John Alford was listed with 40 acres improved land and 600 unimproved-\$300 cash value of the farm. His farming implements and machinery were worth \$100. He had 3 horses, 4 working oxen, 30 other cattle, 50 swine with total value of livestock being \$450. He had 250 bushels of Indian corn, 50 bushels of oats, 800 pounds of rice, 3 bales of ginned cotton weighing 400 pounds each, and 100 bushels of sweet potatoes.

June 1, 1858 he purchased 118 acres, section 7, township 1S, range 7E, from the federal land office in Greensburg. On June 6 of that year he purchased 57 acres section 17, township 1S, range 10E and 37 acres section 18, township 1S, range 10E. May 10 1861 he purchased 22 more acres in section 17. December 20, 1884 he purchased 81 acres, from the New Orleans land office, in sections 18 & 19, township 1S, range 10E.

48. **Jacob Alford** b. Aug 15 1761, Franklin Co., NC, occupation farmer, m. (1) about 1784, in North Carolina, Elizabeth Bryant, b. Jun 20 1765, d. 1789-92, Cumberland Co., NC, m. (2) about 1792, in Cumberland Co., NC, **49. Frankie Seaborn**, b. about 1763, Virginia, d. about 1859, Washington Parish, LA. Some folks believe her name was Martha, some Frances, and some include an initial B. In 1830 she was enumerated in Washington Parish as Franky B. Allford with three sons, a daughter and one slave. 00102-00100001-01 In 1840 she was enumerated with son Joseph, household also had male under 5. She and her son Joseph were enumerated in Washington Parish in 1850. Jacob died Jul 16 1824, Washington Parish, LA.

96. **Julius Alford** b. Sep 1717, St. Peter's Parish, New Kent Co., VA, occupation farmer, m. **97. Lucy _____**, d. after 1790, Franklin Co., NC. Julius died 1771, Bute Co., NC.

192. **James Alford** b. about 1687, Probably New Kent Co., VA, died about 1730, New Kent Co., VA. Birth and death dates are estimates based on other recorded events in New Kent County, VA in the St. Peter's Parish Register. PLEASE NOTE: It is not proven that he was the son of John Alford but there is some circumstantial evidence indicating that he is.
